CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry is the unit of competency which has been developed to meet the requirements of the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work. This training is accepted Australia wide and is a life long qualification which will not require renewal.

Duration: 6 hours

Who should enroll:

- Persons with control of construction projects (e.g. principal contractors, project managers, main contractors, builders, employers, self employed persons)
- Persons with control of construction work (e.g. employers, self employed persons, principal contractors, main contractors, sub-contractors)
- Persons carrying out construction work (e.g. employees, contractors, labour-hire workers)

When should I complete the induction training?

- People with less than 5 years construction work experience including all new people to the construction industry - 19th August 2010
- People with more than 5 years construction work experience - 19th August 2011

On completion of this course, participants will understand:

- Legislation requirements and responsibilities (Employer and Employee)
- Basic concepts of workplace health and safety plans and work method statements.
- Physical building and construction hazards
- Basic risk management concepts including hazard identification, assessment of risk control of risk and evaluation of control measures
- The OHS hierarchy of controls
- Emergency procedures including evacuation procedures and first aid response requirements
