

RIIWHS205E Control traffic with stop-slow bat & RIIWHS302E Implement traffic management plans

Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to control traffic with a stop-slow bat in the civil construction sector and implement a traffic management plan for works on roads, ensuring traffic flow is maintained and risk to the safety of the public and workers is minimised. It includes:

- planning and preparing for traffic management
- setting out the traffic guidance scheme
- implementing temporary signage, barriers and devices
- controlling traffic with hand held stop/slow bats
- monitoring traffic, making adjustments for changing conditions
- using communication devices
- closing down the traffic guidance scheme
- cleaning up.
