Plant Assessment: RIIMPO320F - Conduct civil construction excavator operations

Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to operate an excavator to lift carry and place materials safely, effectively and efficiently according to workplace procedures, including:

- pre-start checks prior to commencing operations;
- driving and operating the equipment to site conditions;
- completing operations using at least two different material types and activities, such as - loading, cutting/boxing, stripping/spreading, lifting and carry materials, bulk excavation, mixing/backfilling, trench excavation, stockpiling, battering, benching;
- selecting, fitting, testing, using and removing at least two attachments
- use a range of communication techniques and equipment essential to the safe completion of work activities;
- written and verbal reporting.

Please Note: This course does not provide sufficient skill to independently load and unload equipment. To perform this activity safely, individuals must either complete, or be assisted by someone who has completed, RIIHAN308F Load and Unload Plant.
