

## Traffic Controller TC1 Skill Set

### Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required for those responsible for traffic control on Temporary Traffic Management Category 1 environments, as described in the Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management.

It includes the skill set

- RIISS00058 - Traffic Controller Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads

The course covers the following:

- Communicate in the workplace
- Control traffic with stop-slow bat
- Control traffic with portable traffic control devices and temporary traffic signs

### Entry requirement:

- Successful completion of CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White card)
- A current drivers licence

### Duration:

- 2 days of training consisting of one day theory and one day simulated practical session
- 9.00am – 3.30 pm each day

### After Course requirement:

- Complete 20 hours directing traffic in a TTM workplace within six months of completing the course
