

Plant Assessment: RIICBS301E - Conduct profile planer operations

Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to conduct profile planer operations that safely, effectively and efficiently follow workplace procedures including:

- prestart checks prior to commencing operations;
- completing profile planer operations to specified tolerances, required line and level;
- removing materials to a thickness and a line/level;
- conducting asphalt paving; milling; edge planning; straight work; confined work;
- tools and equipment types, characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations;
- using appropriate communication techniques and signals in line with site procedures;
- written and verbal reporting requirements associated with equipment operations;
- shutdown procedures on completion of operations; and
- site clean-up requirements.

Location:

Assessments are conducted onsite using the workplace equipment.

Duration:

Assessment is conducted over one day

Cost:

Assessments can be charged per assessment or as a day rate.
