

AHCMOM213 Operate and maintain chainsaws

Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to safely operate a hand-held chainsaw and maintain it in working condition. It applies to cross-cutting fallen timber using safe cutting techniques.

The course includes:

- Preparing the worksite
- Identifying site hazards and assessing risks
- Applying workplace safety procedures
- Identifying hazards and risks relevant to the maintenance and operation of chainsaws
- Safe working practices to manage identified risks
- Routine checks and maintenance prior to operation
- Personal protective clothing and equipment
- Chainsaw operation including – mix fuel and fuel chainsaw; chainsaw faults or malfunctions; appropriate communication techniques; cutting methods appropriate to material type
- Routine maintenance; clean and store chainsaw

Both theory and practical is covered in the one day course. All participants must wear safety boots for the practical component of this course. Safety equipment is supplied.
