

TTM Combo Course for TC1 and TMI1

Course Outline:

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to work in temporary traffic management on category 1 roads. It includes 2 skill sets:

- RIISS00058 - Traffic Controller Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads
- RIISS00060 - Traffic Management Implementer Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads

The course covers the following:

- Communicate in the workplace
- Control traffic with stop-slow bat
- Control traffic with portable traffic control devices and temporary traffic signs
- Implement traffic management plans
- Apply risk management processes
- Position, set up and program portable traffic control devices

Entry requirement:

- Successful completion of CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)
- A current drivers licence

Duration:

- 3 days of training consisting of 2 days theory and 1 day simulated practical session
- 9.00am – 3.30pm each day

After Course requirement to be completed within 6 months:

- Complete 20 hours directing traffic in a TTM workplace (TC1)
- Complete 3 different types of set ups on Cat 1 roads (TMI1)
